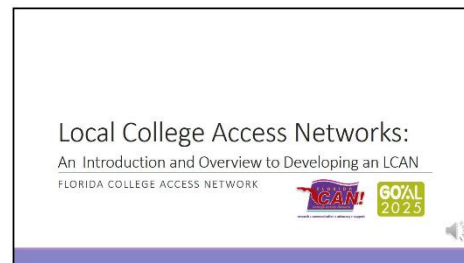




New webinar describes how communities can partner to create local college access networks
